

Saving Asia's Threatened Birds: A Guide for Government and Civil Society

Title BirdLife International, 256 pages **£19 BUY NOW** This book documents the major forest, grassland and wetland regions of Asia and the globally threatened bird species which they support. The most important conservation issues in each of these habitat regions are outlined, based upon the analysis in BirdLife's Asia Red Data Book, and recommendations are made for actions to address these issues. The role of international and regional conventions in the conservation of Asia's birds and habitats is discussed, and the priority actions to prevent the extinction of the region's most highly threatened birds are identified.
