

Title The 3rd Birdwatching Festival in Sagres, Portugal will take place this year from October 5 to 7. Sagres is a very special region located in Algarve (South of Portugal). Not only is the landscape spectacular, but its biological heritage is unique in Europe. It is home to a huge diversity of habitats: woodlands and farmland, estuaries, sand dunes and the sea; where a large variety of native flora and fauna prosper, among which are numerous cetaceans and terrestrial mammals and, of course, many birds. Birds are the main attraction of this festival. In October, Sagres becomes Europe's major migratory corridor for storks, eagles, vultures, hawks and



falcons on their way back to Africa.
