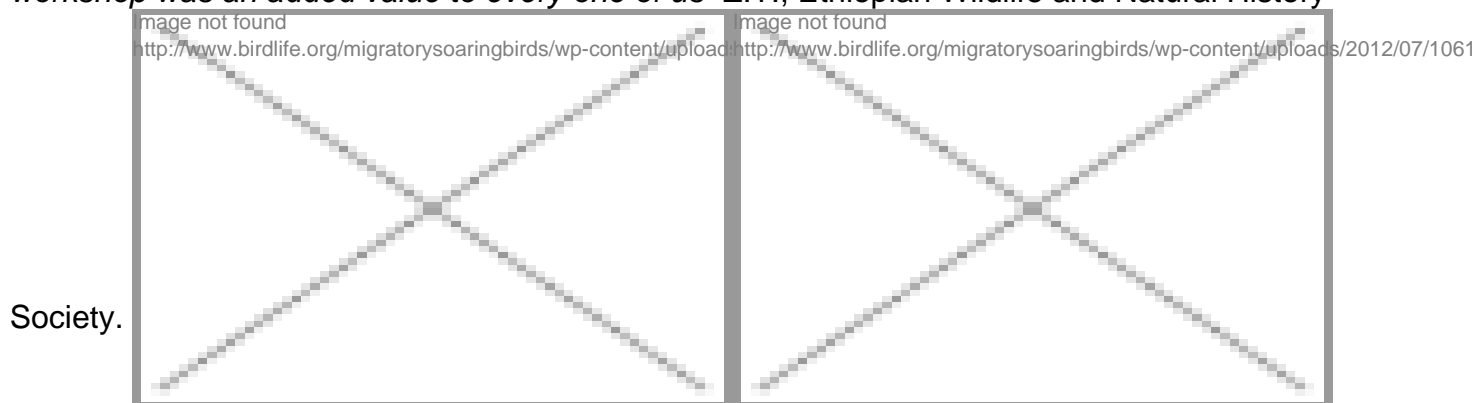




**PARTICIPANTS GO WILD
