"This year's theme aims to raise awareness on globally threatened migratory birds, with a particular focus on those on the very edge of extinction - the Critically Endangered migratory birds", said Bert Lenton, Executive Secretary, UNEP/AEWA. "In line with the International Year of Biodiversity, the 2010 WMBD theme also highlights how migratory birds are part of the biological diversity of our world and how the threat of extinction faced by individual bird species is a reflection of the larger extinction crisis threatening other species and the natural diversity that underpins all life on earth", added Bert Lenton.
