crashed into Nightingale Island, part of the Tristan da Cunha UK overseas territory. Tristan Islanders are doing a sterling job helping the penguins. But they face a race against the clock to save the birds. And even before the disaster, the northern rockhopper was one of the most threatened penguin species.
