- Develop 1-2 project(s) proposals based on the top 2 key issues identified during the workshop and fundraise for implementation.
- Organise training course for ABS staff on bird surveys and identification.
- Acquisition of equipment and materials and installation of basic communication equipment (internet).
- Production and dissemination of advocacy materials
- Liaison with and support to the species guardians in the country.
